GOING FURTHER

Transforme is committed to reaching the widest possible public. Together, the Foundation and its partners present targeted, complementary events in a range of formats (panel discussions, talks, podcasts, workshops, celebrations, sensory visits, etc), with a threefold aim:

- Support for artists on tour, with initiatives outside the sometimes daunting, inhibiting space of the theatre.
- Special, themed events and festivities for young people.
- Inclusive, accessible performances for differently-abled viewers and people with special needs.

OLIVIA GRANDVILLE, ABOUT *L'UMAA*

UMAA (Unité Mobile d'Action Artistique – the 'Unit for Mobile Art Activity') is a protean project conceived by dancer and choreographer Olivia Grandville, its artistic director. Designed by artist Cocky Eek, the inflatable, modular structure consists of different 'bubbles', to be activated in each of Transforme's four host cities: Paris, Clermont-Ferrand, Lyon and Rennes. The Unit offers a completely new approach to the staging of events, as a kind of creative 'citizens forum', adaptable for performances, installations, festive gatherings, practical workshops, participatory art projects and encounters.

At each destination, the mobile Unit will host works by Olivia Grandville and the Ès and La Tierce collectives, together with specially devised activities by Transforme festival artists, or the festival's partners. UMAA is an experimental space for creativity and skills-sharing: a bubble that opens the imaginations of everyone who steps inside. The lightweight Unit adapts to rural and urban settings alike, reaching out to the widest possible public and continually reinventing itself, as flexible and adaptable as the fabric from which it is made. An indoor/outdoor space that encourages osmosis – between performers and public, stage and city.

TRANSFORME

Launched by the Fondation d'entreprise Hermès in 2023, the Transforme festival presents its second season, with the same partner institutions as season one: the Théâtre de la Cité Internationale, Paris; La Comédie, Clermont-Ferrand; Les SUBS, Lyon; and the Théâtre National de Bretagne, in Rennes.

This dynamic venture is rooted in a shared desire to bring vibrant contemporary theatre to new destinations and audiences. Transforme presents works that mobilise viewers and artists alike, as part of a challenging but accessible programme that tackles key issues in today's society, across a broad range of artistic disciplines: hybrid works that push at the boundaries of performance and alter our perspective on the world around us.

Transforme extends and develops the generous support of the Fondation d'entreprise Hermès, for new work by French and international artists. The Foundation supports the staging of each production, some of which have also received funding upstream in their creative process. With our partner institutions, the Foundation works to extend each piece's geographical reach, bringing the contemporary performing arts to the greatest possible number. In each host city, 'Going Further' is an additional programme of events, designed to reinforce Transforme's emphasis on local, grass-roots action and to take the artists' work beyond conventional theatrical settings.
